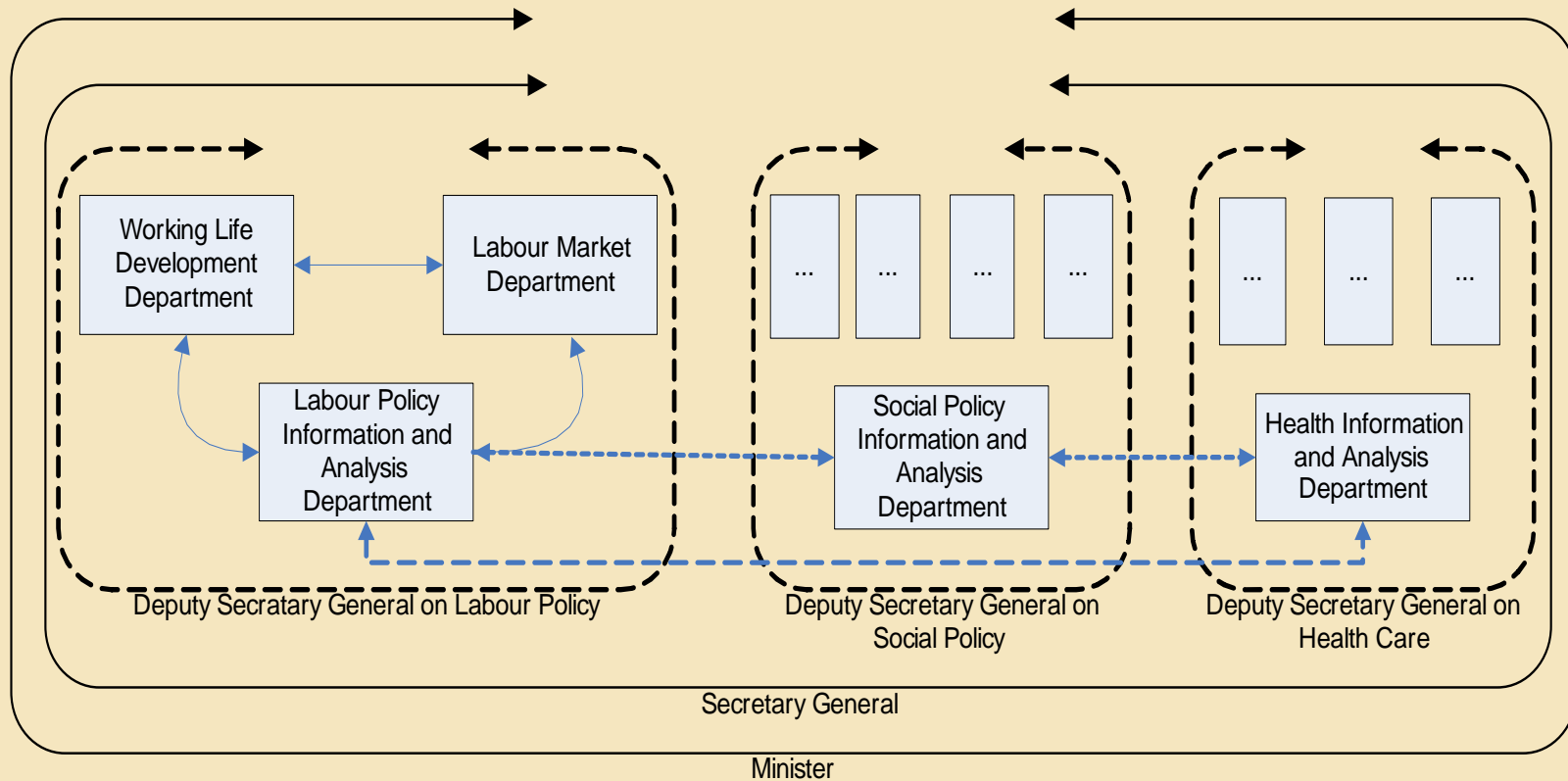
AIMS

Also important is to disseminate more relevant and objective information on labour market policy to public, different organisations and partners

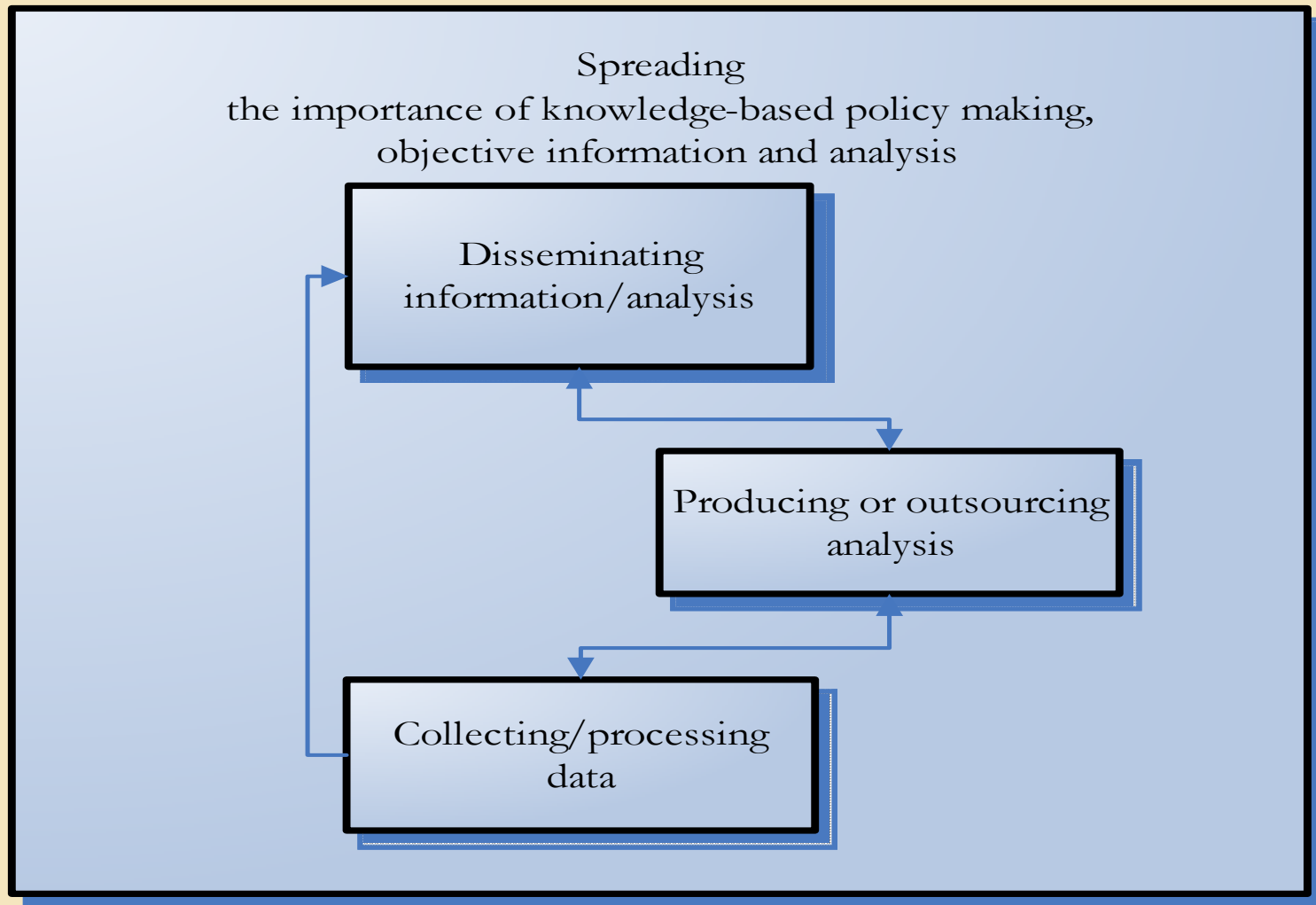


WAYS TO ACHIEVE AIMS - new structure for policy making in ministry



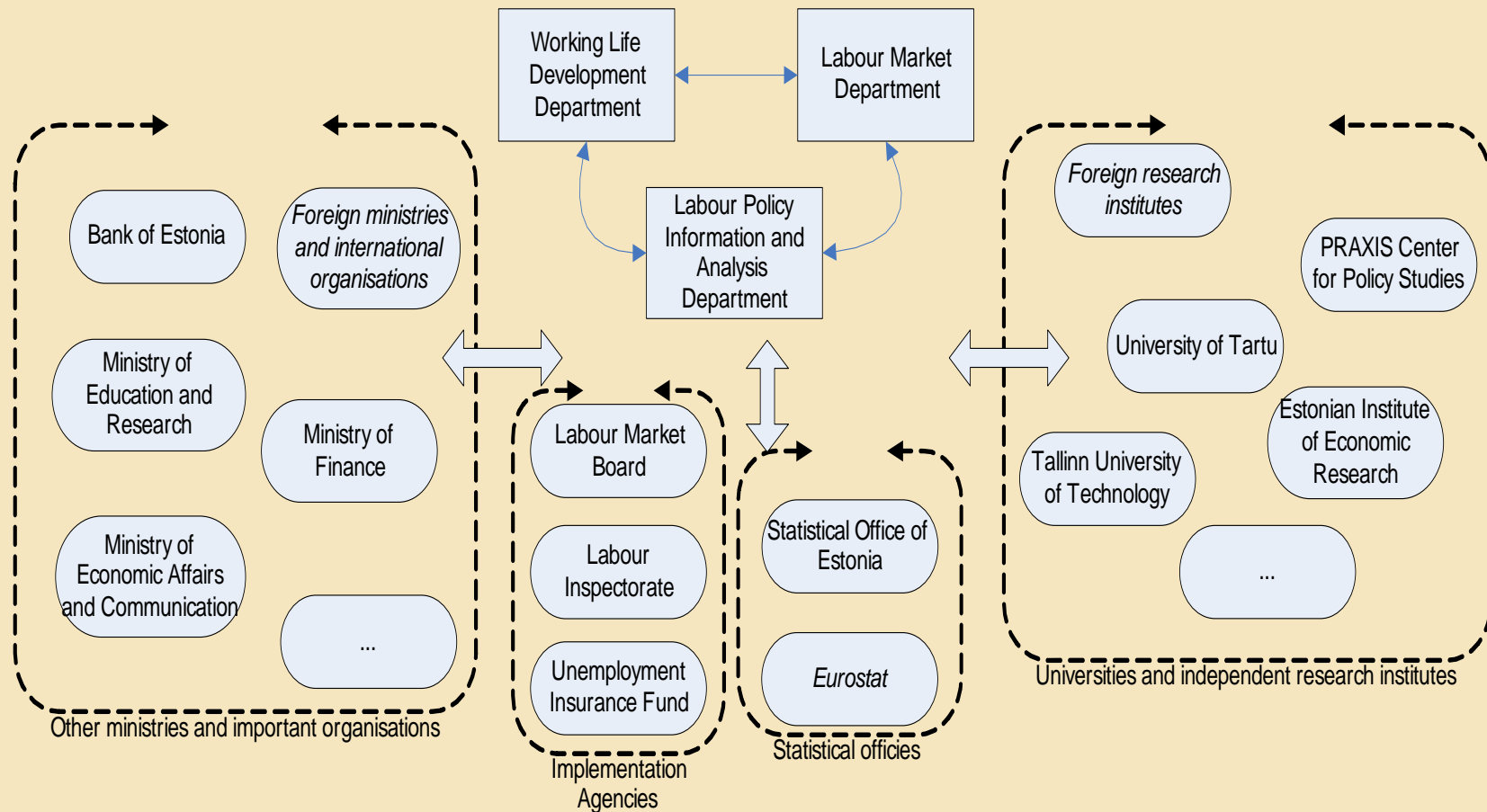


WAYS TO ACHIEVE AIMS - main tasks of Labour Policy Information and Analysis Department





WAYS TO ACHIEVE AIMS – building co-operation networks

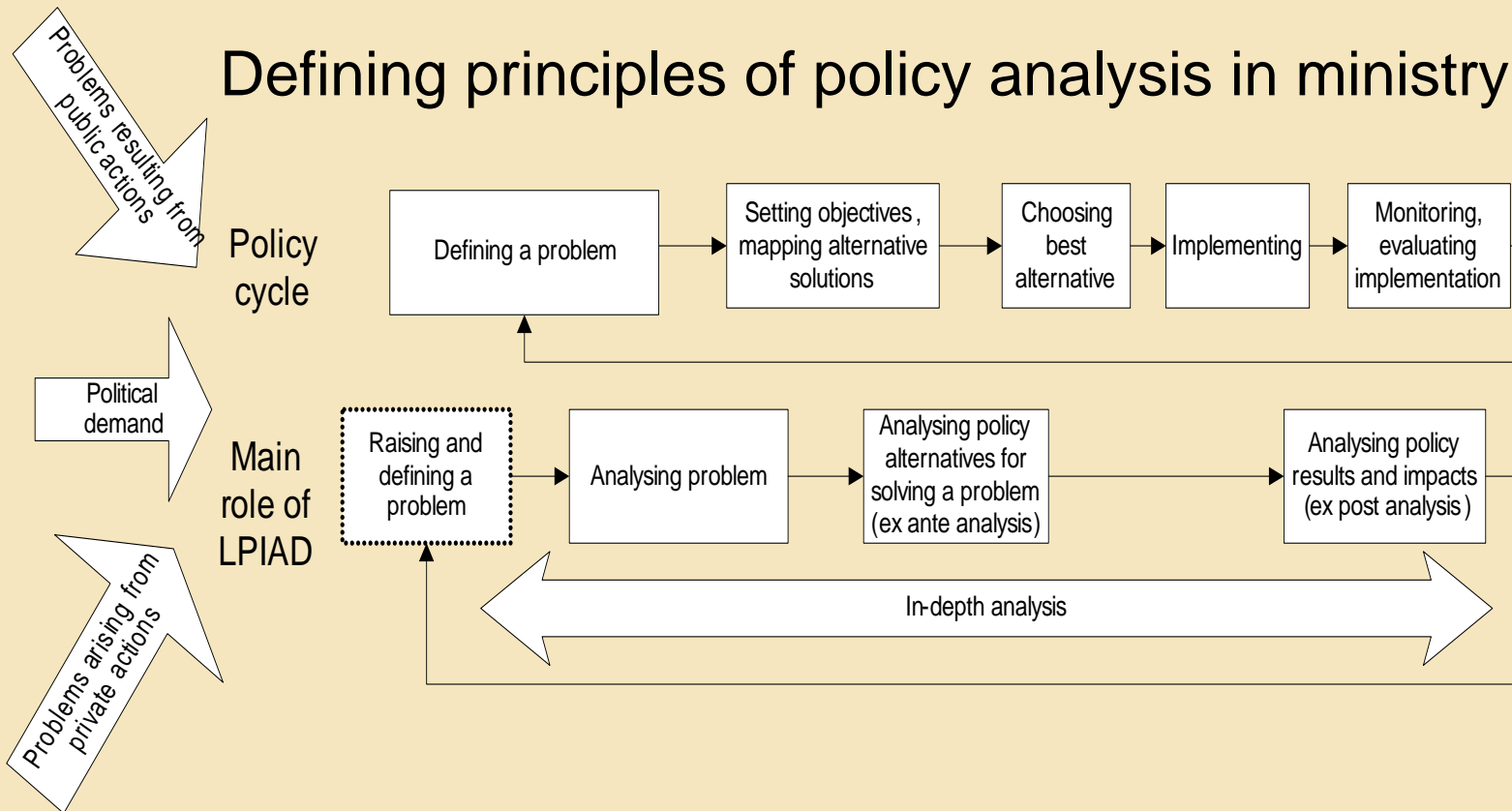

collecting/processing data

- ▶ Defining data needs for analysis, evaluation and monitoring of labour policy
- ▶ Using and improving existing data sources
 - ▶ First priority Labour Market Board, Labour Inspectorate
- ▶ Developing indicators
 - ▶ First priority policy monitoring indicators (strategic, operational, EU)

disseminating information/analysis

- ▶ Establishing labour policy research and best practice database
- ▶ Developing web-based presentation of statistics and indicators
- ▶ Founding publication series
